He served as president of the ND Livestock Endowment Foundation and on the ND Winter Show Board. Stan was the 1997 Agriculturist of the Year,

awarded by NDSU Saddle and Sirloin Club. In 1998 he received the Outstanding Agriculturist Award, representing Sargent County.

Stan served on the Lisbon Hospital Board, Gwinner Farmers Elevator Board and was president of North Sargent School Board for 12 years. He also served on the Federal Landbank Board, several years as president.

He was named Gwinner Citizen of the year in 1994. Stan was a life long member of Gustaf Adolf Lutheran Church in Gwinner and served on the GA Church Foundation committee.

On January 22, 1956, Stan married Betty Lou Carlson in Lisbon, ND. They were blessed with two sons, Steven (Barbara) and Scott (Jan), who continue to farm the Melroe Homestead.

Stan is survived by his loving wife, Betty, sons, Steve and Scott, daughters-in-law, Barb and Jan, grandchildren Tyler (Darah) Melroe, Bethany (Jeremy) Lehrman, Corey Melroe, Lucas Melroe, great-grandchildren Cash & Emerson Lehrman, and Jacey Melroe. Also surviving him is a brother, Sylvan (Caroline) Melroe, and sister Lenore Hodenfield, along with many nieces and nephews.
