When it was decided that we were to sail for Italy, they transferred Paul and some other prisoners to a centurion of the Augustan Cohort, named Julius. ⁹ Since much time had been lost and sailing was now dangerous, because even the Fast had already gone by, Paul advised them, ¹⁰ saying, "Men, I can see that the voyage will be with danger and much heavy loss, not only of the cargo and the ship, but also

of our lives." ¹¹ But the centurion paid more attention to the pilot and to the owner of the ship than to what Paul said. P: The word of the Lord. **C: Thanks be to God.**
