Elementary Faith Formation (Sunday School): This fall we are being church together, across the country, with Abiding Presence Lutheran Church in Burke, Virginia. Together, our kids are exploring through APLC's program what it means that God knows us "Inside Out." We are going to explore what it means to be angry, scared, disgusted, sad, and joyful through a Biblical lens. God made us with big emotions and we are going to discover how they can all be used to worship and glorify God. Our program will follow a workshop model where kids choose which activity they want to participate in for the entire 7 sessions. Each session will include a Bible lesson, which is the same for all groups. Next, they move into their workshop activity where they engage in hands-on activities. Finally, each group will close with the same prayer. 10-12 grade High School students who have participated in our G.A. Fellows training program will be leading our program this fall, assisted by adult mentors.

"God Pause"

<u>Mark 9:38-50</u>

³⁸John said to him, "Teacher, we saw someone casting out demons in your name, and we tried to stop him, because he was not following us." Verse³⁹But Jesus said, "Do not stop him; for no one who does a deed of power in my name will be able soon afterward to speak evil of me. Verse⁴⁰Whoever is not against us is for us. Verse⁴¹For truly I tell you, whoever gives you a cup of water to drink because you bear the name of Christ will by no means lose the reward. Verse⁴²"If any of you put a stumbling block before one of these little ones who believe in me, it would be better for you if a great millstone were hung around your neck and you were thrown into the sea. Verse⁴³If your hand causes you to stumble, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life maimed than to have two hands and to go to hell, to the unquenchable fire. Verse⁴⁵And if your foot causes you to stumble, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life lame than to have two feet and to be thrown into hell. Verse⁴⁷And if your eye causes you to stumble, tear it out; it is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye than to have two eyes and to be thrown into hell, Verse⁴⁸where their worm never dies, and the fire is never quenched. Verse⁴⁹"For everyone will be salted with fire. Verse⁵⁰Salt is good; but if salt has lost its saltiness, how can you season it? Have salt in yourselves, and be at peace with one another."

"We don't do it that way!" Have you ever heard those words in a church community? John's question to Jesus in this week's gospel reading sounds hauntingly similar to the conversation Moses had with Joshua about Edad and Medad in the Numbers 11:28 scripture reading from Monday. John and Joshua express their concern that the Lord's work of exorcism and prophecy was not being done properly or by the right people. Sometimes in our communities we lose opportunities to include people who differ from us because we are too set in our ways, or we miss opportunities for mission. Expect the unexpected in different places and different ways. God is at work in today's church, but it may not be what we are used to, But who are we to place limits on the character or reach of God's mission?

Dear Jesus, help us to remember that if we are too set in our ways, there may not be an opportunity for more s al growth. Help us to see that outsiders can become part of our community. Amen.

Embodied Baptism ~ Affirmation of Baptism at G.A. Church: "Confirmation" is being reformed and renamed - "Embodied Baptism," a baptismal covenant model. This model, adopted from Gloria Dei Lutheran Church, Iowa City, Iowa, focuses on Project Based Learning, Relational Ministry, and Discipleship Development to help our youth and adults live out their baptismal promises: *As you bring [your child] to receive the gift of baptism, you are entrusted with responsibilities: to live with them among God's faithful people, bring them to the word of God and the holy supper, teach them the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments, place in their hands the holy scriptures, and nurture them in faith and prayer, so that your child may learn to trust God, proclaim Christ through word and deed, care for others and the world God made, and work for justice and peace. Students will learn by actively engaging in real-world and personally meaningful projects assisted by their parents/guardians and adult mentors. Embodied Baptism is open to students currently in 7th & 8th grade, with students affirming their baptism as 10th graders.
